

Inglise keele testi sooritamiseks on soovitatav aeg 30 minutit ja maksimaalselt on võimalik saada 100 punkti.

Inglise keele testi koostamisel võetakse aluseks põhikooli riikliku õppekava õpitulemused.

Test koosneb:

1. Teksti lugemine ja sellest vigade ülesotsimine (Error correction);
2. Valikvastustega ülesanne (Multiple choice)
3. Ajavormid (verb tuleb panna õigesse ajavormi vastavalt kontekstile) (Tenses)
4. Sõnatuletus (Word formation)

- Connected text, 12 lines (2 + 10)
